Tonight

- We are going to give you an outline of our residential including where we go, how it is organised, what we do and how much it costs.

Residential

- We have been taking year 2 children on a residential for around 12 years. Children stop over for one night.
- Children always have a brilliant time and still talk about this experience many years later.
- The residential is based on play and being outside.
- Children benefit from spending prolonged time with their friends and being independent.
- It gives them often their first experience of having a sleep over away from home with friends and adults that they know really well

Dates and times:

- Wednesday 28th June – coach will leave Trent Vale at 9.15a.m. with GROUP 1 and arrive at Sherwood Forest Youth Hostel at approximately 10.15a.m.
- Thurs 29th June – coach will leave Trent Vale at 9.15a.m. with GROUP 2 and arrive at Sherwood Forest Youth Hostel at approximately 10.15a.m.
- Thurs 29th June – All Y2s will spend the day together in Sherwood Forest.
- Thurs 29th June – coach will pick GROUP 1 up from Sherwood Forest at 2.30p.m. and arrive back at school at approximately 3.30p.m. Group 2 will then stay at the youth hostel for the night.
- Friday 30th June – coach will pick GROUP 2 up from Sherwood Forest at 2.30p.m. and arrive back at school at approximately 3.30p.m.

- Group 1 going Wednesday 28th June – Thurs 29th June .
- Group 2 going Thurs 29th June – Friday 30th June.

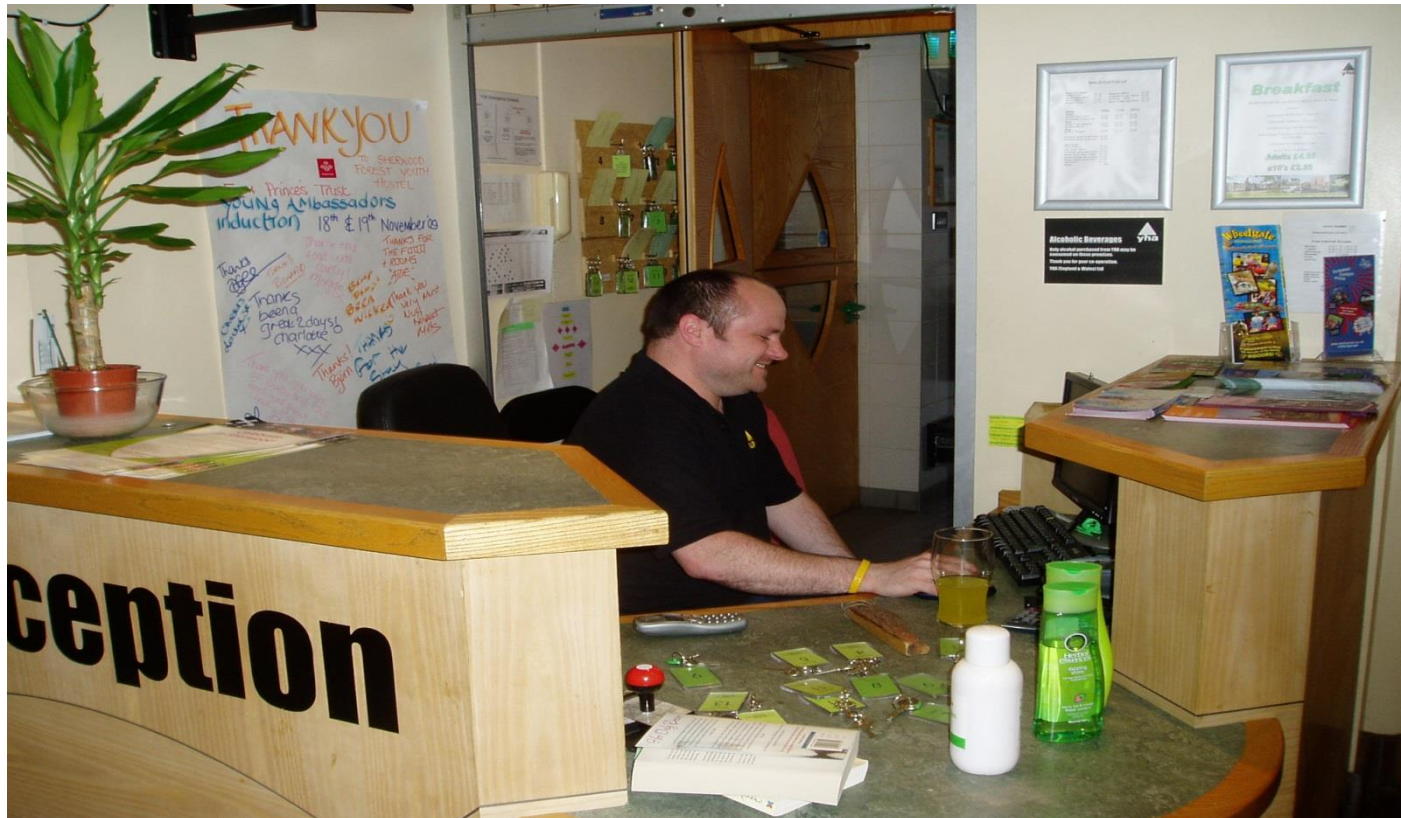

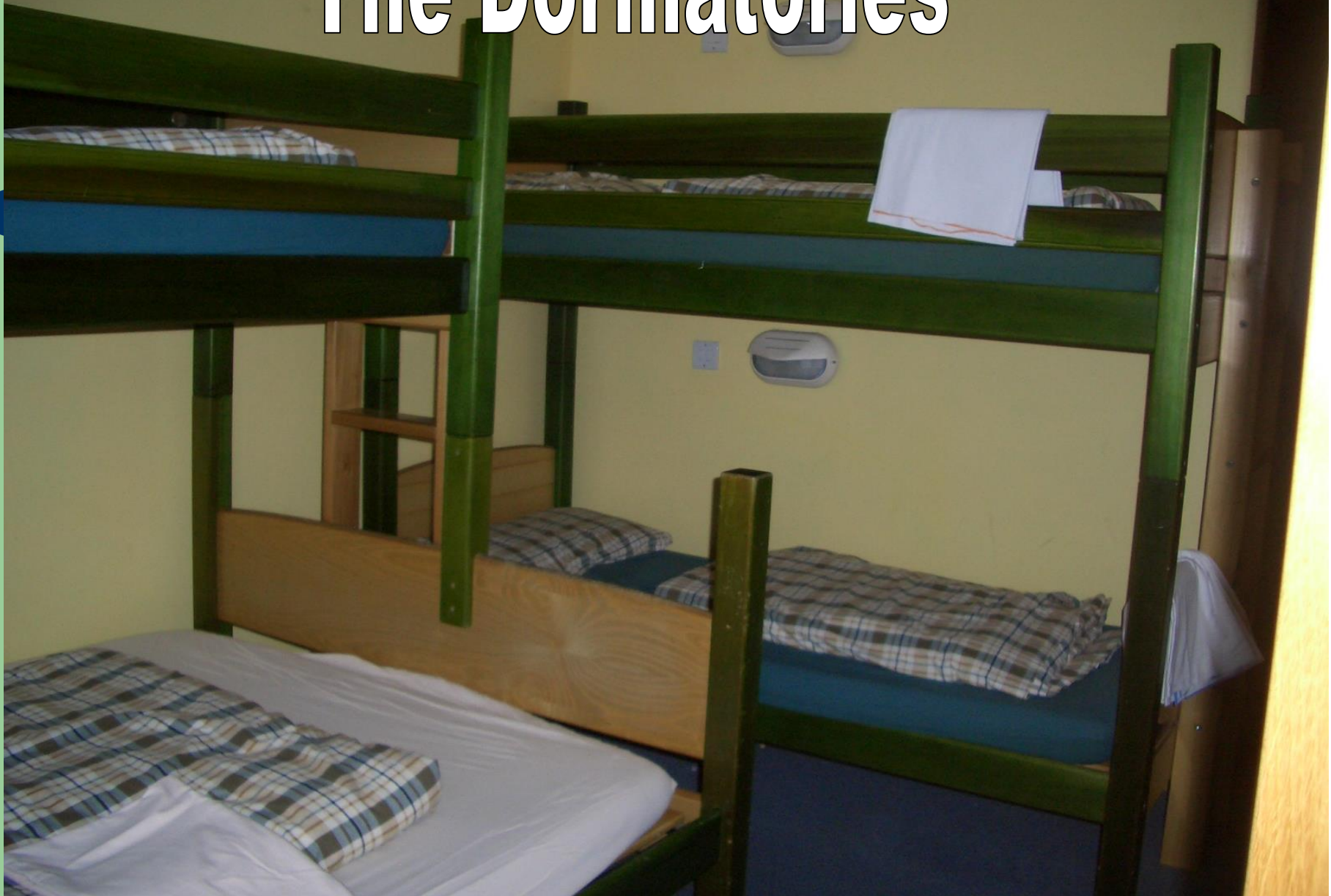

What's Next ?

- It is a long way off so at the moment , we just need to know who will be attending the residential so that we can start the organisation process .
- We would like all the children to go on the residential but we do understand that sometimes children will feel anxious about this. We would like to work with you to reassure you and them about these concerns. Between now and next June children change and mature.
- Closer to the time in May or June we will organise another meeting to sort out the housekeeping around the residential, for example kit, lunches, medical needs etc.

Payment

- The cost of the residential to parents will be £70, the same as last year. The price of the accommodation and transport have gone up this year, but school will subsidise this to keep the cost to parents at a more affordable level.
- All payments must be made using the sQuid online payment system – if you haven't yet signed up, please ask staff in the office for a reminder of your registration details.
- There is a £10 non-refundable deposit due by Friday 9th December 2022 to secure your child's place. Please enter £10 as the amount you wish to pay when using sQuid, unless you wish to pay more at this stage.
- The remaining amount can be paid all at once or in instalments – full payment must be received by 26th May 2023. Please ensure you enter correctly the amount you wish to pay each time you make an instalment.
- If your child is eligible for Free School Meals, all costs will be met by the school and will show as £0.00 on sQuid. However, you still need to give consent to the trip using your sQuid account. Please click 'checkout' to access the consent box.
