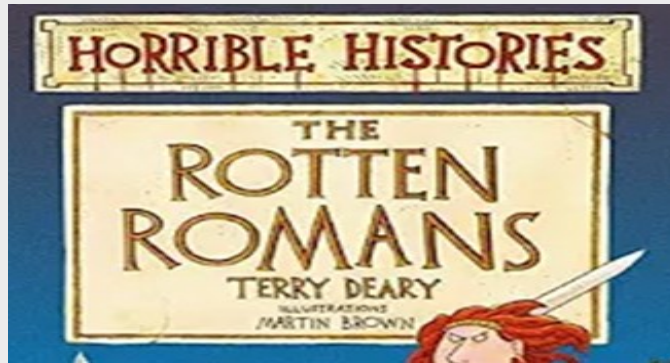


This term's topic is...

Yr 3— we will read different texts during our sessions.

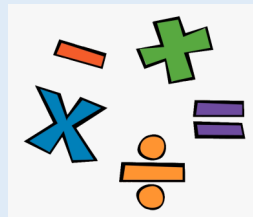
PE
