Number, Shape and Numerical Patterns

We will continue to sing lots of number songs to get the children used to hearing number names and their order in the sequence of numbers.

We will also look at size and make comparisions.

We will continue to look at number 4 and introduce number 5, what do these numbers and amounts look like? A 5 frame is a good way to show what each amount looks like.

We will continue practising recognising amounts without having to count them. This is called subutising. We will continue concentrating on the last number and knowing this represents the total amount.

During our topic we will also be weighing & measuring during baking sessions.

We will look at order and routines and also how to sequence an event and story.

The story will also help us to help positional language and understand what prepositions are.
