

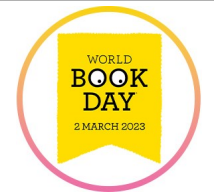

Wider Curriculum

History — We will finish our topic this term, the Anglo-Saxons and the Vikings.

Geography — We will look at the UK and Scandinavia, label maps, compare the climate and describe the landscape

DT — We will be building Longboats

Science — We will finish our unit by building our own instruments.

Languages — We will learn about the weather, telling the time and also our typical day

English

This term, we will be focussing on non-fiction, in particular explanation texts. Within this unit, we will write our own sub-headings, look at vocabulary and plan and write our own text.
