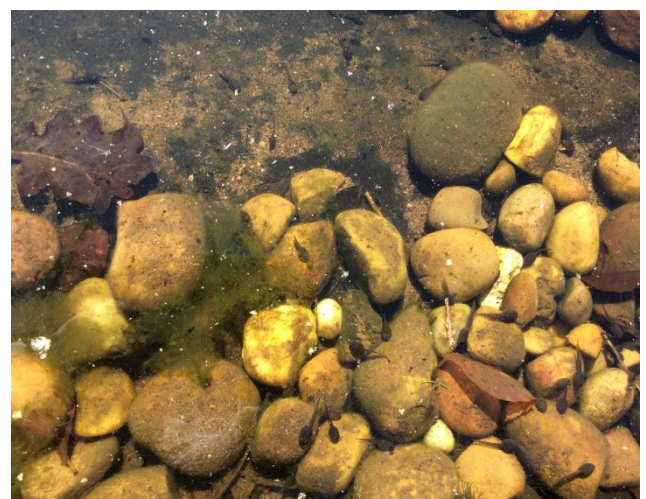
On Friday we joined the whole school for the poetry day and we performed Baa Baa black sheep with Makaton signs and all the grown ups were very proud of us.

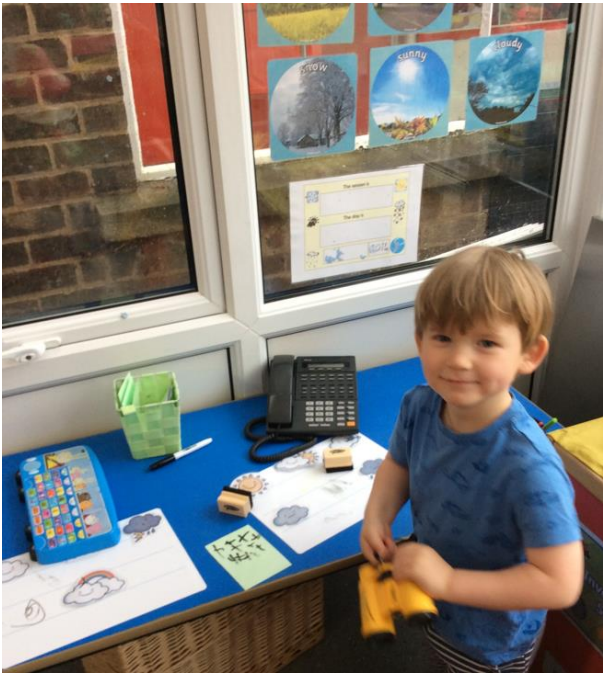
