The Trent Vale Traditional Easter Bonnet Parade

For the Easter Bonnet parade we would like the children to dress up either as something related to 'Spring' and/or in their traditional Easter bonnet. They could wear the Easter bonnet that all the children in their family have worn; they could wear a new Easter bonnet that you and your child have made together; they could wear Spring colours – green, yellow, white, flowers; they could come dressed around the theme of 'Eggs'; or it could be a combination of these ideas. The children will be parading around the hall and they will be singing some Easter songs. We hope you can join us on:

Wednesday 27th March 2024

We are going to do this parade in two parts.

<u>2.00pm – EYFS - Nursery, Beech and Lilac Class</u> will complete their parade. Parents please do not arrive before 1.50pm and wait outside the hall doors on the patio. This parade will be about 20 minutes long. Following the parade, the children will leave the hall and parents can then leave through the patio doors.

<u>2.30 pm – KS1 - Cedar, Holly, Elm , Maple Class</u> will complete their parade. Parents please do not arrive before 2.20 pm and wait outside the hall doors on the patio. This parade will also be about 20 minutes long. Following the parade, the children will leave the hall and parents can then leave.

In order to comply with fire regulations there is a maximum of 2 adults allowed per family. If you have children in both parades, then you can just stay in the hall. Following each parade, parents are welcome to go around through the nursery garden and on to the playground to pick their children up early. The Longlands Gate will not be open, until after the KS1 performance, so the main entrance will have to be used.

We hope you will support us in making the Easter Bonnet parade one to remember.
