Wider Curriculum

History—The Roman Invasion of Britain and what life was like in the Roman Empire.

Geography—Where is Rome located and the spread of the Roman Empire; what modern day countries were once part of it.

Art— We will explore sculpture make our own Roman busts.

Science - Rocks and Materials

D&T—Researching and cooking a Roman Banquet.

RE—We are looking at Christian festivals and beliefs.

Languages — We will be learning the numbers, colours and how to introduce ourselves in German.

Music— We are following a Charanga unit which looks at gospel music, particularly 'Lean on Me'.

Maths

The first part of any year kicks off with place value—recognising, reading & writing numbers, partitioning and rounding. Yr 3 to 1000 and Yr 4 to 10 000. This unit will then be followed by addition and subtraction. We will be using the updated White Rose Maths as a guide as well as other resources.
