RE—We are continuing to look at Christian festivals and beliefs.

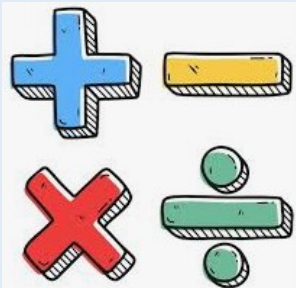
Languages — We will be learning the numbers, colours and how to introduce ourselves in German.

Ash Class—Monday and Wednesday

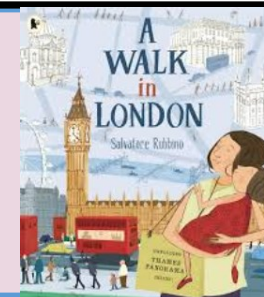
Birch Class— Tuesday (Y3) and Wednesday
