Literacy

Reading - This half-term we will be learning the similarities and differences between the animals and environment we live in and those from the wider world. We will be finding out about animals that use camouflage, are predators and those that are nocturnal. As always, great stories such as Rumble in the Jungle, The Leopard's Drum and Handa's Hen will help us with our learning. We will be continuing Phonics Phase 3, following the Little Wandle scheme, learning how to read longer words and with more fluency. Writing- We will be using the phonics we have learnt to begin to sentences to describe the animals and places we are learning all about

Understanding of the World-There will be lots of learning linked to this area again in Spring 2. We will be learning jungle and safari animals in the 'natural world'. Linked to geography, we will be looking at different places on the globe and finding out what makes the environments so different. Week three is Science week so as we are focussing on our curriculum driver of 'opportunities' we will be finding our how it feels to be a scientist.

Expressive arts and design-There will be lots of animal patterns to explore and replicate with different art techniques during this time. We will also be making and using our own drums and learning a dance to the story of Handa's Hen

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Personal, Social and Emotional Development (PSED)—In this area we will be looking at how we respect other people's views, opinions and cultures. We will look at the big cultural differences between people in this country and those in others and small differences such as beliefs and what we celebrate.

Maths- In maths, following the White Rose scheme, we will be moving onto numbers 9 and 10 in 'Building 9 and 10'. We will find out about the composition and representation of these bigger amounts. We will learn different ways to measure height, length and time. We will also be exploring 3D shapes in our environment. Below is a link to and over view-click on each section to find out more.
