





Subject or measure which the below analysis relates

Shows the range of results for schools in the LA (excluding special schools) for this subject / measure in the stated assessment year (2017 in this example). Broadly the same number of schools (20% or a fifth) are placed in each segment. The lowest ranked school scored 33.3 and the highest school scored 100. This school features in the second quintile (second fifth) for this measure which is identified by the blue box. Schools in the second quintile scored between 60.0 and 67.2. The value in the blue box (65.2) is the schools outcome.


FSM - pupils eligible for Free School Meals

EAL - English as an Additional Language. Any pupils with a language code other than English, Believed to be English, Refused or Information Not Obtained



Trend showing school, LA and



Figures in brackets refer to pupil numbers. In this example there were 23 pupils in the 2017 cohort and 3 FSM pupils.

Phonics - all pupils at end of year 2

Prior to 2024: Cohort is based on any pupil with an assessment at end of key stage 1 or with a year 2 phonics re-check in the stated year. This cohort is then matched to the outcomes for the year 2 phonics re-check cohort for the stated year and any pupils with missing results are matched to the previous year 1 outcomes.

From 2024: Cohort is based on all year 2's recorded in the May school census of the stated year together with any year 2's with a phonics re-check at your school.

Any pupil recorded on your May census but has a year 2 re-check result recorded against another Nottinghamshire school is removed from your cohort and re-assigned to the school in which they undertook the phonics re-check.

This cohort is then matched to the outcomes for the year 2 re-check cohort for the stated year and any pupils with missing results are matched to historical year 1 outcomes.

Any pupil with a missing year 2 re-check outcome AND has a year 1 outcome of Working Towards (Wt), Absent (A), Disapplied (D) or is unmatched to their year 1 outcome (eg. new to the country) is excluded from your cohort as it is deemed that these pupils were no longer at your school during the phonics check period otherwise they would have undertook the re-check with you.
